After tasting the sumptuous food, you can make your way for some cultural experience like Jahar Palace (Istana Palace), which has a long historysince 1855. It was built by Sultan Muhammad II for his grandson, built up of wood with excellent wood carvings. For more traditional handicrafts, of course there is a plenty of museums around the cultural zone, where you can truly get the taste of Kelantan. Lunch stop at the famous 'Nasi Kukus' stall (meal on pax own account). Visit to Bank Kerapu (War Museum). Explore the local temples on this halfday tour and behold some of the finest examples of architecture in Malaysia's east coast. Visit the famous Dragon Temple and Reclining Buddha of Wat Photivihan, one of the biggest Buddhist temples in Southeast Asia.
